5. **Application Ref: 14/11940/LBC**
Application for: Listed Building Consent
Proposal: Reinstatement of ornamental tile hanging at first floor level to front elevation
At: Ham Manor, Ham, Marlborough, Wiltshire SN8 3RB
Assigned Officer: Pippa Card

The Parish Council noted that the central portion of the west front had never been tiled at the first floor level, and therefore it was not accurate to say that putting hanging tiles on that part of the facade was a reinstatement. However, as the 19th century facade, which was unlikely to have been original, was largely destroyed in the 1960s, and as the priority now was to prevent further water ingress, the Parish Council decided that the fact that it was not a true reinstatement did not matter and accordingly supported the application.
