MINUTES OF A PLANNING MEETING

A planning meeting of Ham Parish Council took place at 7pm on 14th September 2020 over Zoom video conference.

3. Matters Arising:

The Minutes of the planning meetings held on the 10th and 24th August were confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

4. Planning Applications

Application Ref: 20/05895/FUL - Full Planning

Application Ref: 20/06659/LBC - Listed Building Consent

Proposal: Reconfiguration of the landscape around Doves House to harmonise its garden setting. Including moving the main access away from the house and setting the gate back from the road, and a new pool house and replacement glasshouse within the garden.

At: Doves House, Ham, SN8 3QS

The Chairman explained that both applications should be considered together. He then asked Clemy Slade, the applicant to give a quick summary of the application.

Clemy gave a summary of the application and explained the rationale behind each main factor.

The Chairman explained that he had visited the site and had no additional comments. David Bicknell also indicated support, particularly with regards to the change in driveway location due to the danger the current junction represents. The Chairman then added that all the close neighbours had indicated they were happy with the proposals.

The council voted No Objections to the application.
